## Role description:

This role is responsible for gathering the views of students at CU Coventry and representing them to the university. They act as the primary spokesperson for all students at their campus, at every level with the university, Students' Union and wider community to ensure that everyone is represented and has the opportunity to shape their university experience. The CU Coventry Campus Officer will also contribute to the development of a student community at their campus through representation, campaigns and events.

Part-Time Officers work 10 hours per week in their role. This will mostly be through representing students at the campus, campaigning on specific issues, running activities or events and talking to students to gather feedback. It is a unique and valuable experience that requires commitment and drive. Beyond a few core meetings you must attend, you get to decide how to focus your time as an Officer representing students and completing your manifesto.

An ideal candidate will be a self-starter, driven and passionate about creating change for students and representing the views of students at their campus. This includes building relationships and managing stakeholders to be as effective as possible. This role is only open to students studying at the campus they will represent: CU Coventry.
