## **Role description:**

This role is responsible for gathering the views of students at CU Scarborough and representing them to the university. The Campus Officer is the primary spokesperson for all students at their campus, at every level to the university, Students' Union and wider community to ensure that everyone is represented and has the opportunity to shape their university experience. The CU Scarborough Campus Officer will also contribute to the development of a student community at their campus through representation, campaigns and events.

The role is self-directed in a number of areas and will require individuals who are self-motivated starters to be successful. This will mostly be through representing students at the campus, campaigning on specific issues, running activities or events and talking to students to gather feedback. It is a unique and valuable experience that requires commitment and drive.
